

INTERNATIONAL RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT

between

SULGRAVE CLUB

Washington, D.C.

and

CIRCOLO DEL MINISTERO DEGLI AFFARI ESTERI

Rome, Italy

- The Clubs covered by this Agreement mutually agree to extend Club facilities to the visitor, provided that a letter of introduction with details about the length of stay from the visitor's home Club is presented.
- 2. Each member will pay the visiting club by credit card before departure.
- 3. The Sulgrave Club is a private social Club for women. It is a distinctly private club. As such, any activity in the furtherance of trade, business or a profession is prohibited. Reservations will be required and all charges incurred by a visitor at the Club must be paid from the personal funds of the visitor and may not be reimbursed by anyone in the furtherance of trade, business or a profession.
- 4. Members of each Club agree to abide by the House Rules of the other Club, particularly:
 - a. Rules concerning the observation of our dress code in our public spaces Coat and tie for gentlemen, and dresses, suits, formal slacks with a jacket, or other attire of similar formality. Casual or athletic attire is only permitted when using our Fitness Center.
 - b. No cell phone use is permitted throughout all of the public spaces in the building.
- This agreement shall remain continually in force until cancelled by either Club, in which case thirty (30) days written notice shall be given.
